Day 1 - Review

Day 2 - Luke 16:14-15

3. Luke 16:14-15 provides the context for our parable this week. From verse 14, determine what the Pharisees thought about Jesus' teaching on money.
4. According to verse 15, how did Jesus admonish the Pharisees?
5. ? Personal Question: How could you personally apply the admonishment Jesus gave to the Pharisees in verse 15?

Day 3 - Luke 16:19-23

(Note: For many Jews, Abraham's bosom or side was a euphemism for heaven/paradise)

6. Contrast the life of the rich man and Lazarus in Jesus' parable.
7. ? Thought Question: What principle is being taught about death in verse 22?
8. ? Thought Question: Why do you think the rich man went to Hades after his death? What did his actions reveal about his heart attitude toward God? (Note: 1 John 3:17 says "If anyone has material possessions and sees his brother in need but has no pity on him, how can the love of God be in him?")

9. ? Personal Question: Do you have a sensitive heart for the poor in our world? What action steps are you willing to take to help those in dire need?

Day 4 - Luke 16:24-26

10. What do you find ironic about the rich man asking Abraham to send Lazarus to Hades in order to give him a drop of water on his tongue?
11. What in verse 25 makes you cringe, and what brings you great comfort?
12. ? Thought Question: What do you believe is the great chasm referenced in verse 26?
13. ? Personal Question: Are you more concerned with your current life or with your life after death? List some evidence to support your answer.

Day 5 - Luke 16:27-31

14. Make a bullet point list of the 5 facts you learn in each of the 5 verses of today's lesson.
