Day 1: Review

3. What lesson is being taught in verses 1-6?

4. What reasons are given for not taking a dispute between Christians to court?

5. **Thought Question:** How might one brother in Christ suing another brother in Christ be a bad witness to unbelievers?

6. **Personal Question:** How might you apply verses 1-6 to your life?

Day 3: Read 1 Corinthians 6:7-11 [\[Open NIV\]](#) [\[Open NKJV\]](#)

7. **Personal Question:** Verse 7 asks the church, “Why not rather be wronged? Why not rather be cheated?” What do you learn from these soul-searching questions offered by Paul led by the Holy Spirit?

8. **Personal Question:** Verse 8 condemns cheating and doing wrong to another Christian. In what way have you wronged or cheated another brother/sister? What action are you willing to take?

9. List the sins from verses 9-10 that keep people from inheriting the kingdom of God.

10. According to verse 11, how did some of those practicing the sins mentioned in verses 9-10 ultimately inherit the kingdom of God?
